#### **Exploring Careers in Filmmaking**

Film Director	This person is responsible for creating the story, characters, and dialogue for a film.	
Film Producer	This person is responsible for planning and coordinating film production such as choosing the script; coordinating writing, directing, and editing; and arranging financing.	
Cinematographer \		
Writer	This person controls almost everything about a film including the film's artistic and dramatic elements. They are involved in the film from the very beginning until it is released in theaters.	
Video Editor	This person manages the camera and light teams working on the set and is the person in charge of actually shooting the film.	
	This person makes all the changes to the film including adding filters, cutting out unnecessary parts, and adjusting the sound.

## FEATURED ROLE: RUNNER

- Many filmmaking professionals start out as Runners.
- Production Runners help out wherever they are needed and are usually based in the production office.
- Floor Runners carry out tasks on the set or location to help the progress of the shoot, running errands including making teas and coffees.
- **VFX Runners** work with the postproduction teams and learn VFX skills by assisting.
